## **Worship through Reading ..... Psalm 106:1-23**

Ask someone from your family or you yourself read this passage aloud. If possible, stand as you read and hear the word of God. Ask someone in your family to pray a prayer of Thanksgiving after you read.

## **Worship through Song .....**

This last song is, again, one that we have never sung at one of our Worship Services. If you look at the progression of the songs this morning, we go from declaring the glory of the Lord to proclaiming Jesus as our savior to requesting the blessing of God to remembering that it was Christ's work on the cross and in the grave that brings salvation. This last song, sung by Chris Tomlin, is a beautiful reminder of God's worthiness. Play it as a time of reflection. If you know the song, sing along. The lyrics are on the video if you want to learn it.
