Worship through Reading Matthew 21:1-11

Today is Palm Sunday, where we remember the Triumphal Entry of Jesus into Jerusalem a week before His Resurrection. We want to pay special attention this morning to how Jesus was ready to face death for you and I to gain life. Ask someone from your family or you yourself read this passage aloud. If possible, stand as you read and hear the word of God. Ask someone in your family to pray a prayer of Adoration to King Jesus after you read.

Worship through Song

Worship through Reading Psalm 106:24-48

We continue now with our regularly scheduled reading of the Psalms. Ask someone from your family or you yourself read this passage aloud. If possible, stand as you read and hear the word of God. Ask someone in your family to pray a prayer of Thanksgiving after you read.

Worship through Song

This last song is one that may be familiar with you, but has not been sung at our church gathering in quite a while. This song is a beautiful reminder of how God loves us. What was He thinking as He watched His only son ride into Jerusalem on that donkey? What was Jesus thinking as He heard the crowd cheer His name? They both knew what would be happening on the coming Friday. But, onward they went, for you and for me. Play this video as a time of reflection and if you know the song, sing along.
