



RESURRECTION ROLLS

A simple activity to teach about the Resurrection during Easter.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 can refrigerated crescent roll dough
- 8 large marshmallows
- 3 Tbsp. butter
- 1 tsp. Cinnamon
- ¼ tsp. Nutmeg
- 1/3 cup Sugar

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Preheat oven per instructions on crescent rolls.
- Take one triangle shaped section of crescent roll. This represents the cloths that Jesus was wrapped in for burial, and later the tomb.
- Take one marshmallow which represents the body of Christ.
- Combine the sugar and spices. Melt the butter. This represents the oils and spices the body was anointed with upon burial.
- Dip or cover the marshmallow in the butter and roll or sprinkle the sugar mixture. This represents how Jesus' body was prepared for burial
- Lay the marshmallow on the dough and carefully wrap it around the marshmallow. This represent how Jesus was laid in the tomb.
- Make sure all seams are pinched together well. (Otherwise the marshmallow will "ooze" out of the seams) This represents how the tomb was sealed so that no one could get in or out.
- Bake according to package directions.
- Cool.
- Break open the tomb and the body of Christ is no longer there!!
- Celebrate God's love
