

Making It Count – Book of Numbers
“Purification Laws”
Numbers 19

Sin corrupts and God purifies by His work and word.

1. **Unclean** – A state of being, where a person has broken the ritual law of God. A clean person is free from physical, moral or ritual contamination.

Hebrews 10:26-31; James 3:14-18; Titus 2:11-15

2. **Impurity** – An action or object that makes a person unclean.

Romans 1:24-32, 6:12-14; Galatians 5:19-21;

3. **Defiles** – A process of making a person unclean.

Matt 15:15-20; Mark 7:18-20; Hebrews 12:12-17

4. **Cut-off** – To destroy, remove, or exclude from the blessing of God. This word also refers to how a covenant is made.

Hebrews 3:7-17; Luke 10:30-37; 1 Cor 6:9-10

5. **Perpetual Statute** – A defined law or ordinance prescribed for the length of the covenant.

Hebrews 7:24-28, 8:13, 13:11-14
